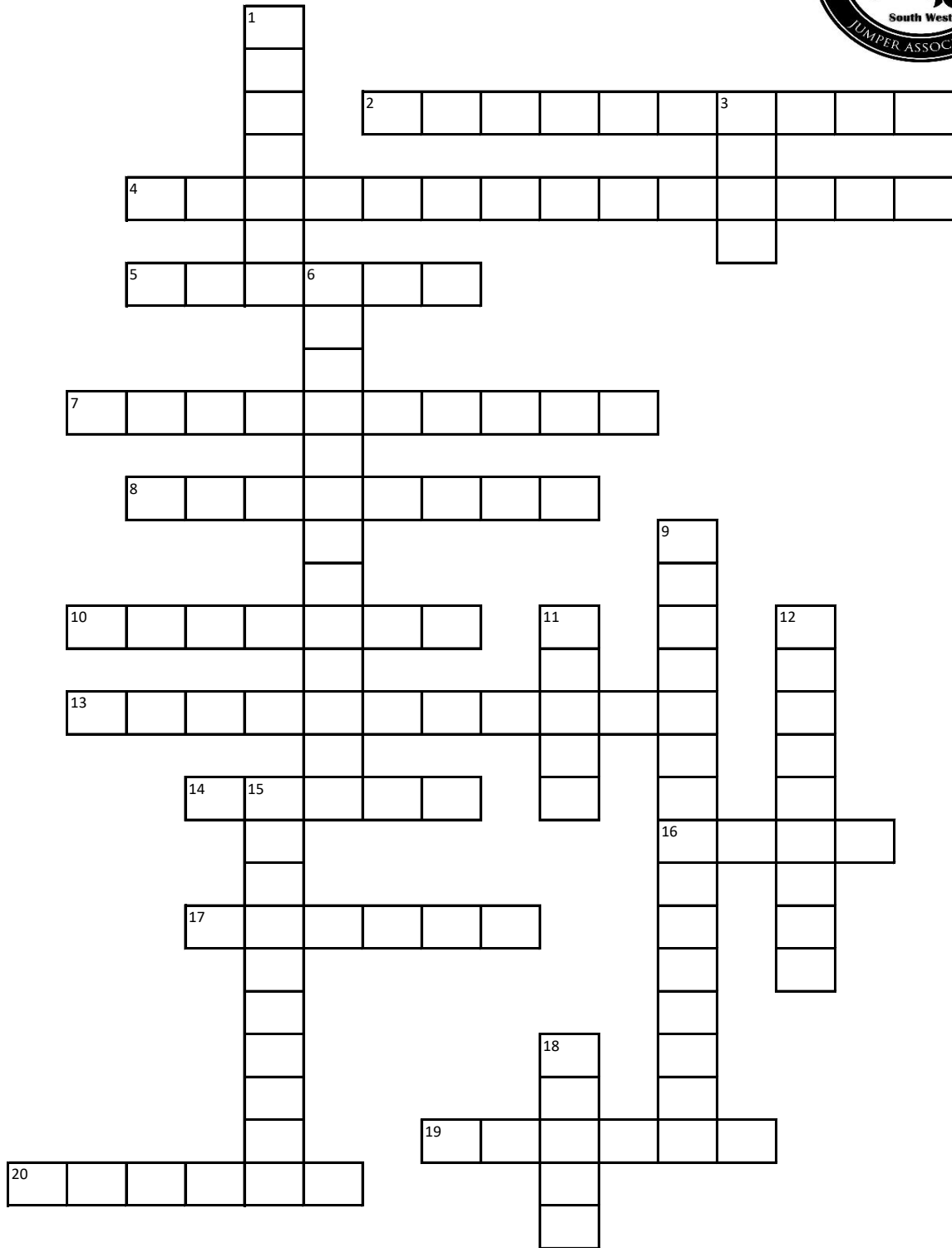


South West Trillium Crossword

1. Used to develop riders, but using a posted time.
3. May be asked for collected and extended gaits
6. Two phases run continuously with the second phase against the clock
9. The athlete must choose their course ensuring that all obstacles are jumped only once.
11. 50% of the course is natural obstacles with one jump off
12. Height of jump is gradually increased
15. Judging based on rider form and function.
18. Shows rideability with turn backs, trot fences and option lines.

2. Teams of riders compete over two rounds for their country
4. Points are awarded according to difficulty for each obstacle successfully jumped.
5. Scoring is based on faults and time.
7. May be asked to jump one or two jumps not exceeding 1.10m.
8. To be shown on light contact at the walk, trot and easy canter. Not to gallop.
10. Combined numerical scoring over two rounds determines final placings.
13. High performance class judged on performance, pace, style, handiness and brilliance.
14. Two phase competition with over fences and flat phase.
16. May be asked for a strong trot and hand gallop.
17. Six verticals in a row made of poles.
19. Judged on jumping style, manners and way of going
20. Judged on conformation and suitability
