### THJA POINT CALCULATIONS

Please make sure that horse show secretaries/zone points keepers responsible for THJA points for Zone Awards and Trillium Championship Show Qualification are aware of these policies to avoid competitor disappointments moving forward.

Points cannot be awarded until THJA membership is confirmed for both the rider and the owner of the horse. This **MUST** be done via the THJA portal at [www.thja.ca](http://www.thja.ca) and not just assumed because there is a number in the THJA line of an entry form. Show secretaries can be given access the portal to confirm memberships.

Points cannot be awarded if either the rider or owner of the horse do not have current Equestrian Canada Silver Sport Licenses, Horse Registrations or Ontario Equestrian Memberships. Temporary licenses **DO NOT** allow for point collection.

THJA Points are calculated as follows:

Number of horses marked on the judge's card in the division/class\*\* X placing points X standard multiplier of 8

Placings are valued as follows:

First Place: 6 points

Second Place: 5 points

Third Place: 4 points

Fourth Place: 3 points

Fifth Place: 2 points

Sixth Place: 1 point

Riders must be a THJA member of the zone in which they are collecting THJA points. The owners may be a THJA member anywhere in the THJA, they do not need to be zone specific.

\*\* In the event that horse show management combines two divisions during the course of the regular competition season, points are to be awarded according to the number of horses entered in the division in which that entry is collecting points. For example if Juniors and Amateurs are combined and there are 3 Juniors and 5 Amateurs the points are awarded to the Junior based on competing against 3 Juniors and to the Amateur based on competing against 5 Amateurs. A junior cannot collect points based on showing against an amateur. This rule does not apply if the decision to combine divisions is made by the zone at the beginning of the season for the entire season.\*\*

In order to qualify for Championships competitors must compete (compete = marked on a judge's card) at 50% of the zone shows in their respective divisions and classes (with the minimum number being 4 shows). Simply entering the show does not count as having competed.

Keep in mind that this policy does not apply to points for Champion and Reserve Champion awards at individual shows. Those rules are available in the EC Rulebook.

**THJA points cannot under any circumstances be awarded retroactively.**
